## **IMPORTANT EVENT DETAILS**

### **Bio Security Details**

A Horse Health Declaration including PIC details will be required to be produced for each horse attending, before admittance to the venue will be granted.

NB: PIC numbers are required for where the horse is kept and where the horse is going. **Bassett Park PIC is QERM0021.**

**Please note that Roma is a TICK FREE AREA.** Please refer to <http://www.dpi.gov.au>

### **Documents for moving stock from a place in Queensland cattle tick Infected Zone (stock includes Horses)**

1. QLD Travel Permit.
2. QLD Livestock Movement System – Move Easy Waybill.

### **Conditions of the Travel Permit.**

1. Owner or Person in charge of the stock **MUST** be aware of all the conditions of the Travel Permit.
2. Movement by direct conveyance to and from the venue, and must be completed within 5 days of entry into the grounds.
3. A Fully Completed Waybill/NVD with Travel Permit Details endorsed must accompany the stock.
4. Stock must be treated by either:
  - a) Accredited Tick Control Personnel in the infected zone or
  - b) The owner in complying with the Schedule of Conditions of the Competitive Stock Owner Treatment Scheme
  - c) Inspector of Stock or Approved Person

## **Team Managers Duties**

- To ensure that the contents and requirements of the Event Bio Security Risk Mitigation & Emergency Contingency Plan are known and understood by all Team members and supporting personnel.
- To ensure that prior to the departure for the event that a complete list of Team members and their mounts has been received from the Zone Secretary and that all Team members have been advised of the name and contact details of the Team Leader.
- To attend all Team Managers meetings – listed as per discipline and brief Team members on the outcomes of those meetings.
- To at all times, wear an identifying badge.
- To be responsible for the distribution and collection of backnumbers.
- To act on behalf of and be responsible for all team members whilst at the event.
- To inspect uniforms and gear of competitors before they report to Gear Check Stewards and attend gear check with competitors.
- To be wholly responsible for lodging of protests, that MUST be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident along with a \$50 fee. (While the Team Managers may have assistance, any official representations or protests MUST only come through the Zone Team Manager).
- To assemble the Zone Team as and when required and ensure their timely attendance at presentations and other required gatherings.
- To present and collect performance cards.
- To ensure Zone helpers and other duties are fulfilled promptly and expeditiously.

**All zones will be required to supply helpers for this event. A roster will be given at the team manager's meetings. It is the responsibility of the team manager to ensure that helpers are available when required.**

## **Disclaimer of Liability**

Neither the organising Committee, nor the PCQ accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, and ground spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. The organising committee reserves the right to combine or split classes according to the numbers nominated.

## **Reservation of Rights**

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- a) Cancel any class or event;
- b) Divide any class;
- c) Alter the advertised times;
- d) Refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason;
- e) Transfer competitors between sections of a class;
- f) Combine classes if less than 3 competitors.

## **Protests**

Must be lodged in writing by Team Manager within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident occurring and must be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

## **Rules**

1. Team Managers and competitors are expected to be familiar with all the rules. PCQ updated rules are published in the minutes and it is the duty of the club secretary to advise members of any changes.
2. The Judge in Chief and Chief Steward together with PCQ, reserve the right to alter, amend or delete any part of the program if the circumstances present.
3. Competitors may exercise their horses in the area provided. Horses may be schooled or exercised only by their nominated rider on the day of the competition. Competitors must NOT ride on or near any part of the Official Course prior to the competition. Riders disregarding this rule will incur disqualification from the event.
4. Horses must be correctly saddled and competitors must wear an approved helmet and riding boots at all times when mounted.

## **Presentation**

All zones are requested to bring their Zone Banners for the Grand Parade to be held at the conclusion of the event and prior to the presentation of Championships Awards. Full uniform is required to be worn. All riders are required to stay for the presentation which may be mounted or unmounted at the organising committee's discretion.

## **Interstate Teams**

Nominations must come through the PCQ Office. Interstate competitors ride under PCQ rules. Horses with a higher EA grading than PC grading, must ride in whichever is the higher grade.

## **Age**

As at first day of competition.

## **Age Champion**

For Formal Gymkhana and Sporting Championships: Highest points decide the placings. Points are awarded 10 – 1 descending to 10<sup>th</sup> place. In the event of equality, the winner is the rider with the most 1<sup>st</sup> placings. If scores are still equal, the most 2<sup>nds</sup> and if still equal, the most 3<sup>rds</sup> and so on. If a result is equal in every case and the results cannot be obtained, a tie should be declared.

## **Draw**

Final copy of the draw will be displayed on the morning of the Competition, after the Team Managers have given scratchings. Copies of the draw will be available for purchase.

## **Refund of Entry Fees**

Entry Fees will be refunded if the organising Secretary is advised before the start of competition, such advice of withdrawal being accompanied by either a Veterinary Certificate for the horse or a Certificate from a Medical Practitioner for the rider. 10% of the entry fee may be retained to cover administration.

## **Substitution**

Mounts may be substituted before the commencement of the event upon presentation of a Veterinary Certificate or a written statement from the Club Chief Instructor. If such substitution is made, the replacement mount must be eligible as per PCQ rules. No substitution of rider is permitted under any circumstances.

## **Zone Teams Championship**

Teams will consist of four riders from one Queensland zone, with the best three scores to count. Where there is equality of points within the team, the rider competing in the higher grade takes precedence. If from the same grade, then rules for equality of points in individual events are followed. Where there are less than 6 riders in a competition, only the first overall placegetter is eligible for the State &/or Zone Team (Oct.12).

## **State Team Championship**

For interstate competition – teams are to consist of the four highest scoring riders from the one State, with the best three scores to count. Where there is equality of points within the team, the rider competing in the higher grade takes precedence. If from the same grade, then rules for equality of points in individual events are followed. Where there are less than 6 riders in a competition, only the first overall placegetter is eligible for the State &/or Zone Team (Oct.12).

## **Additional Criteria which applies to ALL Disciplines**

1. To count as a Qualifying Event, Zone Championships must be run in the same format as a State Event and have been applied for and approved by the relevant PCQSub-Committee.
2. To attend a State Championship, **all riders 13 years & over are required to hold a minimum "C" Proficiency or Level C Instructor's certificate (Aug.09), all riders under 13 years are required to hold a minimum "D" Certificate (Aug.10)**. A photocopy of the Certificate will be required with the nomination.
3. **All riders nominating must have attended at least TWO musters (rallies) in the past twelve months** at their club or previous club in the case of transfers or club where they are attending as an 'honorary' member because of school or work commitments.
4. **Zone Secretary &/or Zone Delegate** to check qualifying criteria have been met, copy of proficiency certificate attached, attendance requirements verified, before sending in nominations. Club Secretary to check all requirements for nomination are complete and correct before forwarding to zone. Riders to complete nomination correctly as incomplete forms will be returned. Riders found not to be qualified may be stopped from competing.
5. **"Pending" Qualifications will not be allowed unless specifically stated by PCQ before the closing date (due to enforced cancellation of events) and must with a date on which "pending qualification" closes.** In these circumstances, the rider **MUST** nominate by the original closing date with a note of where they hope to qualify. If they are successful in qualifying, they should advise their Zone and the Organisers by the extended date.
6. **Extenuating Circumstances.** On a case by case basis, where there are genuine extenuating circumstances for non-qualifying, the rider may apply to a Zone Committee made up of Zone Chief Instructor, Zone President &/or Secretary plus the discipline delegate to the PCQ Sub-Committee. This committee will consider, agree and recommend whether or not the rider/horse combination is of sufficient standard to compete.
7. **Injured horse or substitution of horse.** Refer Extenuating Circumstances above. The same Zone Committee – being satisfied that the horse originally qualified and nominated is unable to compete – would approve any substitution of horse after due to consideration and agreement on whether such horse is of sufficient standard to compete in its nominated group.
8. **Special Consideration.** Where a 12 & under rider will move to graded competition after the close of nomination, he/she will be allowed to ride HC (taking part in all second rounds as applicable) in the new grade for up to 3 months preceding turning 13 years to gain experience at the new level prior to the State Event.

5. Riders must supply a legible copy of both sides of their performance card when nominating and produce the card at the event, showing they have satisfied the criteria in point 2 above.
6. Achievements meeting the criteria obtained at the previous year's State event are eligible as one qualifier.
7. Whether rider/horse combination qualifies has no bearing on their places on the day.
8. Where a rider's age necessitates going up an age group, before the State Championship, horse & rider combinations who have qualified as above will be considered qualifies to compete at the new level. Anyone going up an age after the close of nominations, previous qualification will be accepted.

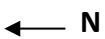

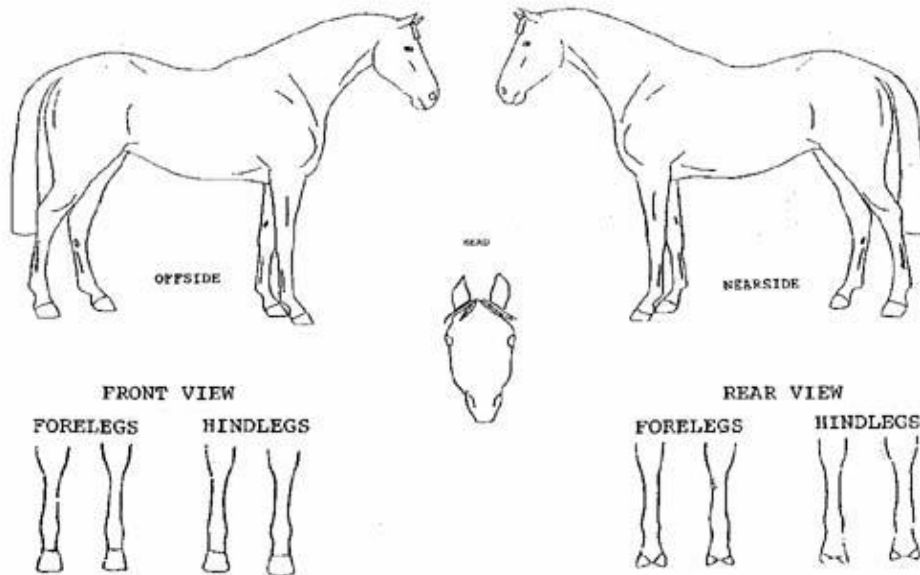
