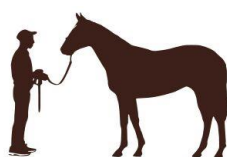

## LOCAL INFORMATION

The **Sydney International Equestrian Centre (SIEC)** for short) is the facility which was used to host equestrian events during the 2000 Summer Olympics.

The centre is located 45 kilometres from Sydney's business district and the harbour at Saxony Road, Horsley Park.

Construction began in 1997 and was finished in 1999.

Having played on the world stage at the Sydney 2000 Olympics and Paralympics equestrian events, the Sydney International Equestrian Centre remains the location of choice for a wide range of local and international equestrian and sporting events.

Set on 96 hectares of rural parkland in Western Sydney, the Sydney International Equestrian Centre delivers international standard facilities that include:

- Major indoor and outdoor arenas
- 10 kilometres of trails
- Steeple chase track
- Cross country course
- Stables
- On site event accommodation
- Conference room
- Riders Retreat
- Parking

## GROUNDINGS REGULATIONS & GUIDELINES FROM SIEC & PCANSW

- Approved safety helmets to be worn at all times when riding.
- Riding of unbridled horses is prohibited.
- Stallions are ineligible for PCA Championships and therefore no stallions are allowed on the grounds during these Championships.
- As the Sydney International Equestrian Centre is a public venue, drivers of vehicles must be licensed and speed limits must be adhered to.
- Dogs must be on a lead at all times and must remain in the camping area, no exceptions.
- No horses are to be in the camping areas, no exceptions.
- The cross country course is off limits until after the Eventing Championships and the jumps are off limits at all times.
- Power leads must not run over roadways.
- Electric fences and portable yards are prohibited.
- Athletes, Managers and Supporters are to obey any directions as issued by the Organising Committee or any member of the PCA NSW organisation.

# GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter amend or delete any part of the program if circumstances arise which make it necessary.

## Dressage, Showjumping, Eventing, Tetrathlon & Formal Gymkhana

- Rider's Age – as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019
- Sub-juniors: 10 years and under 13 years and a member of a Pony Club affiliated with Pony Club Australia
- Juniors: 13 years and under 17 years and a member of a Pony Club affiliated with Pony Club Australia
- Seniors: 17 years and under 26 years and a member of a Pony Club affiliated with Pony Club Australia
- Each State/Territory are permitted to enter six riders in each age group in each discipline (Dressage, Showjumping, Eventing, Tetrathlon and Formal Gymkhana)
- Teams to be a minimum of three riders and a maximum of six riders – exception Dressage
- Teams – top three scores to count – all riders are considered to be the team – exception Dressage
- Points are accumulated from each event
- All competitors will be scored for individual championships
- A minimum of two states will be needed to constitute a National Team Championship event otherwise the event will become a competition for individuals only
- A mounted presentation will be held for each discipline – with the exception of rugs presented by sponsors to the winners, rugs may not be worn at this presentation.
- A warm up round available for all disciplines except Mounted Games and Quiz.

## Prince Philip Mounted Games

- Rider's Age – as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019
- Juniors – under 16 years
- Seniors – 16 years and under 26 years
- All riders to be current PC members (subject to State/Territory rules)
- Each State/Territory permitted one team of five athletes in each age group for Prince Philip Mounted Games
- A mounted presentation will be held – with the exception of rugs presented by sponsors to the winners, rugs may not be worn at this presentation.

## PCA Quiz

- Rider's Age as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019
- Each state is encouraged to enter two teams – Junior and Senior
- Juniors – 10 years and under 17 years
- Seniors – 17 years and under 26 years
- All riders to be current PC members (subject to State/Territory rules)

## LOCATION OF EACH EVENT AND RELEVANT PHASES (MAP PROVIDED CLOSER TO THE EVENT)

- Dressage – Arenas 7, 8, 9 & 10
- Showjumping – Indoor Arena
- Eventing – various (on-site)
- Tetrathlon – various (on and off-site)
- Formal Gymkhana – Hacking arena
- Mounted Games – Hacking arena
- Quiz – Rider retreat

**For all disciplines: One horse one rider; one rider one horse.**

Horses may participate in a maximum of two disciplines. A horse may compete in any two jumping disciplines but NOT ON THE SAME DAY. Jumping Events include Showjumping, Eventing, Gymkhana and Tetrathlon.

Two horse rule – 2019 exception - If a discipline team of three cannot be made from State nominations, then a second competition horse is allowed from an already competing rider, where the second mount is also qualified to compete. That is, a State has only two nominated horses and this enables the State to field a team.

Substitutes due to injury or illness will be at the discretion of each State/Territory up until the commencement of competition of the discipline entered and horse must have passed the veterinary check (Trot Up).

For the 2019 Thoroughbred Industry Careers Pony Club Australia National Championships, Gear Rules as per EA.

**The 2019 Nationals will be run under EA rules.** The only change will be that each state can wear their State Pony Club Uniform.

**There will be a gear check steward who will check all riders before each event. Failure to do so will entail elimination.**

PLEASE READ THE CURRENT EQUESTRIAN AUSTRALIA RULES SO YOU HAVE THE CORRECT GEAR.

## GUIDELINES FOR EACH DISCIPLINE

Sub-junior, Junior and Senior competitions will be held for the following disciplines:

- Dressage
- Showjumping
- Eventing
- Tetrathlon
- Formal Gymkhana

Junior and Senior competitions will be held for the:

- Prince Phillip Mounted Games
- PCA Quiz

### Special Events:

- International Challenge – showjumping – format and rules determined by PCA

The **Roger Braham OAM Perpetual Shield** will be awarded to the Champion State, awarded over all Championship disciplines competing at the event.

- Dressage
- Showjumping
- Eventing
- Tetrathlon
- Mounted Games
- Formal Gymkhana
- PCA Quiz

Championship points will be allocated with the winning team for each discipline receiving the same number of points as there are competitive teams, with the Team who scores last position receiving 1 Championship point, ie, if there are 7 teams, then:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place = 7 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 6 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 5 points
- 7<sup>th</sup> place = 1 point

### Scoring – Individual

- The number of riders starting in the first event will determine the point allocation for the subsequent events, ie if 22 riders start in the first event, the scoring system for the second event is based on 22 riders and if only 20 riders start, the scoring system remains at 22.
- The winner of each event at Preliminary will be awarded points equal to the number of riders in the first event, ie 22 starters = 22 points.
- Each Preliminary rider who completes an event will score points according to the placing in the field.  
Eg, 1<sup>st</sup> place = 22 points  
2<sup>nd</sup> place = 21 points  
3<sup>rd</sup> place = 20 points  
21<sup>st</sup> place = 2 points  
22<sup>nd</sup> place = 1 point

Each Novice rider will follow the same pattern, however they will start with 5 points above the preliminary rider (eg 27)

Each Elementary rider will follow the same pattern, however they will start with 10 points above the preliminary rider (eg 32) –for the Teams event the riders must have **gained over 58%** to be eligible for the champion team.

Competitors compete at the three consecutive tests in the level they have chosen.

Each rider can only ride each championship test once. (The test event – Warm Up Event - is not included).

- WARM UP EVENT - A 'Warm Up' test is available on the first day of competition if riders would like to enter one. (This is a non-competitive test that is optional) Tests 1C, 2C or 3C.

5. If a rider is eliminated in an event they will not be awarded points for that event, however, they are eligible to score points in other events which accumulate to the Individual and Team Championships.
6. Equal placings will be separated for each Championship event.
  - a. The higher total collective marks will decide the higher placing.
  - b. If these marks are equal, then placing remains tied.
7. Points awarded at the completion of each event will be totalled to determine the final results of the Individual Championships.
8. In the event of an equality of the total points at the completion of the events comprising the Championships, the outright winner or higher place getter will be determined as follows:
  - a. Highest score in the highest numbered test.
  - b. If these scores are equal, places will be determined as for the single event, using the highest numbered test.
  - c. If there is still a tie this process is repeated with the next higher numbered test until a winner is determined or until there are no further tests to compare, in which case the placing remains tied.
9. If a placing is tied in either dressage section and cannot be split after applying the countback system, the points for the tied placings are added together and divided by the number of tied competitors.
10. A competitor must have ridden all Championship events to be eligible for an award.

### Scoring – Team

The final placings of each event are determined by ranking riders according to the dressage scores (from each level of Preliminary, Novice or Elementary), gained and then allocating the corresponding points as per the individual scoring. Taking the three highest scores the aggregate point scores for each team member are added to give the final team score.

A minimum of three team members must ride all Championship events before the team is eligible for an award. Teams may consist of three riders from each state.

1. If an equal place exists in any section, the process for 'Separating Equality of Scores of Teams' will be applied:
  - a. In the case of equality of points, the higher placed team is the one whose lowest classified competitor of the three scores to count has the highest result.
  - b. If these figures are equal, the placing remains tied.
2. Teams of three are eligible for a team award. If one or more of these three riders fails to start in any Championship Event, then the Team is ineligible for the Team Championship.
3. Teams with less than three members may ride and each member may be eligible for an Individual award but are not eligible for a Team award.

### Heights

Sub-junior – maximum starting height 80cm in each Championship Event

Junior – maximum starting height 1.05m in each Championship Event

Senior – maximum starting height 1.10m in each Championship Event

### Scoring – Individual

Step 1: Determine the Individual placings for each event according to the class articles.

Step 2: Use the Points System to allocate the corresponding points to each rider.

1. The placing of an Individual Rider is decided according to the table in use and the instructions of the general program for the event or amendments noted on the course plan.
2. Riders who are unable to complete the first round of an individual event cannot obtain a score for any subsequent round of that event.
3. All place getters must take part in the presentation ceremony and should do so with the placed horses. The Judge, however, for safety reasons, may make exceptions. If a place getter fails, without plausible excuse, to take part at the presentation ceremony, the Judge, at their discretion, may decide to withhold their award.
4. WARM UP ROUND A 'Warm Up' round is available on the first day of competition if riders would like to enter one. (This is a non-competitive round that is optional)  
Article 238.1.1 (one round not against the clock)

## Points System

1. The number of riders starting in the first event will determine the point allocations for the subsequent events, ie if 22 riders start in the first class, the scoring system for the subsequent events are based on 22 riders. If only 20 riders start the second event the scoring system remains at 22 and so on.
2. The winner of each event will be awarded points equal to the number of riders in the first event. E.g. – 22 starters = 22 points
3. Every rider that completes an event will score points according to their placing in their field:  
Eg,    1<sup>st</sup> place = 22 points  
          2<sup>nd</sup> place = 21 points  
          3<sup>rd</sup> place = 20 points  
          21<sup>st</sup> place = 2 points  
          22<sup>nd</sup> place = 1 point
4. If a rider is eliminated in an event they will not be awarded points for that event. However, they are eligible to score points in the other events.
5. These individual rider points for each event are added together progressively throughout the Championship to determine the Individual Champion.
6. In the event of an equal placing in an event, the scores will be added together and divided equally.

## Scoring – Team

1. Teams consist of a minimum of three (maximum of six) riders with the best three scores to count. In order to be eligible for a team placing at least three members of the Team must complete each scheduled event.
2. A minimum of three team members must ride all Championship events before the team is eligible for an award.
3. Points obtained by the three highest placed riders in each Team for each event are totalled for that event.
4. In the case of the equality of points for the final placing, the scores will be added and divided equally. If these are still equal then the placings are tied.
5. If a rider is eliminated which would preclude the team from obtaining a team score, then the eliminated rider can continue for the team (receiving 20 penalties more than the worst placed competitor who has finished that particular round), thereby enabling the team to be scored in the following way:
  - a. If the team is a two round event then the rider carries that score into the next round.
  - b. If the team event is for example an AM5 then the score obtained by the above method becomes the rider's team score.

## Scoring – Individual

Individual scoring shall be as per the Eventing rules.

The same rider must complete all three phases, mounted, on the same horse.

1. Disqualification or elimination from one phase involves disqualification or elimination from the whole competition.
2. The placings are reached by adding together all the penalty points incurred in the different phases.
3. Scoring of Individual Champion to be calculated from the three Championship phases. The winner is the competitor with the lowest total penalty points.
4. In the case of a tie, the winner or place getter will be determined in the order as follows:
  - a. The rider with the lowest Cross Country (total of jumping and time penalties).
  - b. If there is still a tie, the winner or place getter will be the one whose Cross Country time was the closest to optimum time.
  - c. If there is still equality, the placing will be decided in favour of the competitor with the best score in the Showjumping phase (time and obstacles).
  - d. If there is still equality, the placing will be decided in favour of the competitor with the fastest time in the Showjumping phase.
  - e. If there is still equality, the placing will be decided in favour of the competitor with the highest percentage score in the Dressage phase. If there is still equality, the tied placing will remain.
5. WARM UP TEST - A 'Warm Up' test is available on the first day of competition if riders would like to enter one. (This is a non-competitive test that is optional) Tests 1C, 2C or 3C. or riders may have a 'Warm Up' round (This is a non-competitive round that is optional) Article 238.1.1 (one round not against the clock)

## Scoring – Team

1. Teams consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of six riders.
2. For scoring purposes, the 'Team' shall be defined as the three riders with the lowest penalties after all phases have been scored.
3. The winning Team for Eventing will be that Team which scores the lowest total of penalties accumulated across all three phases.
4. In the case of a tie for 1<sup>st</sup> or any other place, the higher placing Team will be determined in the order as follows:
  - a. The Team with the lowest penalties in the Cross Country phase (total jumping and time penalties).
  - b. If there is still a tie, the higher placing Team will be that one whose Cross Country time was closest to the optimum time.

## Scoring - Individual

Competitors score positive points according to the standard of their performance in each phase.

- In the event of an equality of points, placings will be determined as follows:
  - Highest points in the riding phase
  - If still equal, highest points in the running phase
  - If still equal, highest points in the swimming phase
  - If still equal, highest points in the shooting phase
  - If still equal, the tie shall remain.

## Scoring – Team

1. Teams consist of a minimum of three and a maximum of six competitors.
2. For scoring purposes, the 'Team' shall be defined as the three competitors with the highest points at the conclusion of the Individual Championship.
3. The winning Team will be that Team which scores the highest total of points accumulated across all four phases.
4. A competitor must participate in each of the phases to remain eligible to be considered a member of the Team. If a member of a Team of three fails to participate in any phase, the team will no longer be eligible for the Team Championship.
5. Each team will have a maximum of three male competitors per team.
6. In the event of an equality of points, placings will be determined as per the Individual Championship using the aggregate points for the three team members in each phase.
