Roper Boot Approved

That roper or dogger type boots can be worn for sporting & campdrafting competitions with riding trousers.

The "roper" style of western boot has a shorter boot shaft. They also have a low and squared off "roper" type heel usually less than 1" high and a rounded toe.

The term "dogger" relates to both a brand name (Thomas Cook boots) and that the calf ropers & steer wrestlers both liked the "roper" style of boots as they could run in them easily and they also came off easily if caught up in saddle or gear.

Below are some examples of Roper/Dogger boots:



Not acceptable are any other types of Western boots – ie: dress boots – Cuban type heels, pointed toes & any metal tips.
