

NSW ADVISORY COMMITTEES

Advisory Committees to consist of maximum of **five** appointed persons, who must be members of Pony Club Association NSW (PCA NSW). Expressions of interest will be called for from interested parties. Term of Committee is **three** years or part thereof. The first term finishes at July State Meetings in 2022. Persons may serve a maximum of **two** consecutive terms.

Persons will be appointed by the Chair of the ZCI Committee, the Deputy Chair of the ZCI Committee and the Association President (or their nominated representative from the State Executive). The Chair of the ZCI Committee and PCA NSW President are ex-officio members of the advisory committee. Persons may only sit on **two** Advisory Committees at any one time. State Executives may only sit on **one** Advisory Committee at any one time.

Advisory Committees may appoint (co-opt) up to **two** additional delegates with relevant qualifications or experience within their sport. These delegates may not necessarily be members of PCA NSW.

It is expected that Advisory Committees will convene (either through email or tele-conference etc) regularly throughout the year. A report from the committee (including any recommendations) is to be received by the Chair of the ZCI Committee prior to the quarterly PCA NSW State Meetings. It is suggested that Advisory Committees try to organise a face to face meeting at the conclusion of the State Event for their Discipline to discuss any possible changes or improvements required.

PCA NSW will reimburse travel expenses (at their set rate) and provide share accommodation for Advisory Committee members who are required to attend State Events.

It is expected that members of the Advisory Committees will;

- Strive to improve the participation and standard of riders in their discipline,
- Work towards improving the management, planning and running of State Events,
- Keep up to date with rule changes by other State or National Organisations in their respective discipline and advise PCA NSW of those changes, e.g. Equestrian Australia, AMGA, ABCRA etc.
- Annually, or as required, review the PCA NSW Blue Book section of the respective discipline and advise PCA NSW of any changes required.
- In Co-operation with the PCA NSW State Events Co-ordinator and the Nominated Technical Delegate plan the annual State Events.
- Liaise with PCA NSW State Coaching Director of needs within the discipline relative to their position, e.g. Judges Schools, TD Schools, Rider information.
- Where required attend and assist TD and host zone in running State Events annually.
- Provide recommendations to PCA NSW Executive on selections for State Camp, PCA Nationals teams, and NSW representatives to PCA teams.
